DESCRIPTION Post hole. The apparant rabbit run between F252 and F254, although its fill is disturbed by ? moles?, is a pair of post holes intersecting and covered by the chipple packing found around the other postholes. Tentative phasing at this stage is, then, as follows: -

II Posts removed, and replaced when the chipple leveling was put down, and used as packing around posts. In this phase some post holes, such as the two excavated today, were filled, or capped over, with chipples therefore disused in this phase. These two postholes called FN 263 + 264.
