Description continued

Soil content and incidence of burnt small stones was sufficient to warrant sectioning, and a quantity of bone, sherds, flint were recovered. The feature proved to be vaguely rectangular in shape and of shallow depth, with a base of flat bedrock. PWD suggests that the base showed signs of wear. On its south side the feature merged with F. 1459 (see p. 80) One drawing inc.
