ASSOCIATED FINDS

- ex depth As per section ① 7335
- 0.13m COMMENT ① In brown soil, occ burnt stones
- 0.14m ② reddish brown soil, small stones, little chippie (less than ①), few medium - sand stone, some burnt stones
- 0.20m ③ dark greyish brown with "bluish tinge" (chemical weathering?)
- 0.08m chippie (more than ② & ①) very few stones though some still burnt
- 0.18m ④ very burnt stones in a greyish brown matrix
- 0.26m PHASING ⑤ A zone with a stone, ~~plus~~ a slightly greyish brown soil/chippie fill
- ⑥ small stones in a brown soil matrix
- ⑦ see ② of Gavin's section
- ⑧ weathered light grey brown soil with few medium & lg stones several small stones

The pattern of burning & the scar line are low water (B) suggest a
 Pollack trench with a post setting.
