Hearth, but one with only one built side. The burnt material associated with it extends 70cm to E. of it.

STONES ARE MOSTLY BURNED ON EAST SIDE. THIS STONE BUILT back KERB WAS A SECONDARY INSERTION AFTER INITIAL FIRST USE OF FIRE.

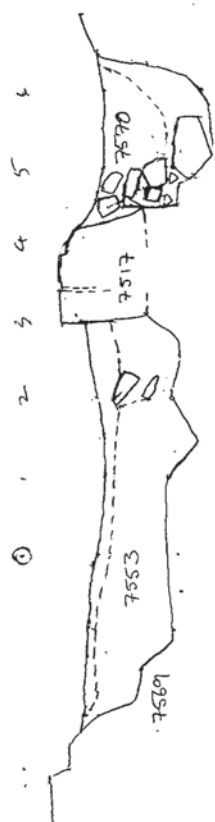
PHASING 7517 continues to the SW, under 7555 in the form of burnt rocks as opposed to burnt slabs
