COMMENT *The Northern of two stone built lobes or wall stubs / nibs. ? Internal junction of house associated with fireplace. On excavation (16-8-86) this lobe was proven to be integral with build of wall 7509, indicating that it is an original feature of the house. On the other hand, the line of small/med. burnt stones below the lobe indicate that it, like 7555, was ~~not~~ a secondary feature.*
