COMMENT *One of two 'lobes' internal junction of house ? This lobe represents a reslabbing of the hearth complex because it rests on medium-sized burnt rubble chunks of the type built into the hearth spine. The lobe is thus perhaps secondary - although only marginally - to the PHASING lobe 7554.*
