COMMENT
In 1971. The shape of the post hole was sub-circular after excavation, and the slight indentations in its sides were suggestive of re-use. The infill was a uniform chipple / brown soil. This post hole was situated close to two definite stake holes to the East. It cannot, at present, be linked to any other feature.
