COMMENT W of the 5m line in G15 the turf is very uneven with 1 clearly visible animal hole

A RABBIT WARREN.

All runs connecting to this complex will be numbered 7302

NOTE the runs are over a number of layers in G15, F15, F16.

PHASING Most of the runs are filled with a dark brown soil. A few are filled with a reddish brown soil which is noticeably less compacted than the surrounding area
