COMMENT Burning continued throughout the context. Full chipples, small stones. Poss P.H. No clear edges in 7333 material though burning disappeared. Further excavation shows a rabbit run cutting through the N and W sides of the area. The base of the P.H. appears higher than bottom of the burning run (see feature plan).

Poss P.H. looked prob on initial excavation.
