COMMENT

Possible wall-line: single layer, with
 chaffle below in most places, though some
 angled stones in the centre of the n.e. edge
 proved later to have other stones below them
 (see 7233 & 7249), and stones persisted in
 patches at the n. and s. ends of the feature.

PHASING

Runs between 7255 and 7360 at n.w. and 7248 and
 7249 (all postholes of longhouse) at s.e. and appears to
 extend into F16 at 7522 and 7523, if not 7524, and to
 meet 7548/7256 at right angles. Is parallel to 7557.
 Its position, at right angles to and between the pairs of

postholes, seems to relate it to the longhouse, though
it was slightly above the level of the packing stones
of 7249.
