COMMENT One of a number of groups of stones larger than those that make up 7211, and one of a number of groups of burnt stones in the area. Distinct from ?7221 and 7222, which are isolated, but similar to 7224, in that it occurs at the end of a band of unburnt stones. 7256 considered a possible wall, as the s. end of 7224 forms part of the w. end of 7257, which runs parallel to 7256.
