ASSOCIATED FINDS Pebble, bone, burnt bone, pot, tooth, burnt tooth, charcoal, daub, burnt clay

COMMENT Lies immediately e. of 7215, one of the bands of large stones assumed to form the walls of the S. A. house, though it is at some distance from the other walls, 7216 and 7214. 7280 is below the centre of it. Large number of finds from s.e. corner of the area were very burnt, and there was charcoal in quantity right across the feature from n.w. to s.e.

PHASING Is outside, to e. of walls of S. A. house. Completely surrounds the area occupied by 7280 and 7214 below, with dark soil and burnt rubble between.
