COMMENT 9.8 Half-sectioning revealed medium-to-large angled stones almost immediately with little soil: assumed not a pothole.  
19.8 Reinvestigated in relation to 7285, of which it had proved to form part. The two features were amalgamated, the number 7285 being used for both, except that the soil samples were listed under 7243.
