ASSOCIATED FINDS Lamb bone, pot, burnt bone, charcoal, tooth,
quartz, flint, big hill gritCOMMENT Considerable amount of soil removed, after
one layer of large unburnt stones, the walls
of the house, as well as the top layer of
burnt stones (medium-sized) had been lifted off. Later, a
hump remaining over 1 sq. m. centred on
3.00E 8.50N removed ("Layer 2") before a second
layer of large and burnt stones taken off.
