COMMENT Possibly part of house wall.

Removal of large stones — single layer — showed material below that of 7211 generally, though some chaffle above sparse medium-sized stones at the n.e. end. Continues into F16 at 7548. Lies parallel to 7257 and the posthole of the longhouse, and at right angles to 7218/7522/7523 and 7557/7342. At s.w. extremity, which includes 7223, lies just beyond the extension of a line through the southernmost posthole of the longhouse. Meets the w.w. corner of 7534 (F16) at right angles, but it is a less substantial feature than 7534.
