ASSOCIATED FEATURES 7260

ASSOCIATED FINDS Pot, worked limestone, charcoal, bone, alien stone, burnt tooth, daub, burnt bone, chert.

COMMENT Removed to see if there were elsewhere, medium-sized angled stones such as those in the already-visible patch on the w. edge of 7211 (7720). Two removals revealed other patches of medium-sized stones in the s.e. quarter (7284 + 7287) but no general spread.
