COMMENT This number used for both a layer and an area. As a layer it covers the removal of small stones and associated soil from that part of the general area 7211 bounded by the semicircle of burning 7232 and extending 1.00 m. of the widest part of that feature (see 7259 for removal of small stones over the rest of 7211). The area was separated out so it could be investigated for features that might relate to the semicircle at the same time as it was searched for medium-sized stones similar to those already visible in its w. half (7285). No further features and no further medium-sized stones were found. The removal of a further layer of stones and soil (characteristic of 7211 material) showed that 7289 could be extended to cover this area for further removal of material.
