COMMENT Possible stakehole - not one.
The first to be noticed of a number of patches
of burnt chiffle in the vicinity of postholes 7280
and 7227, all of which were found later to
be parts of an extensive area of burning,
7713. 7261 was at the n.e. extremity of
this area, which proved on investigation to have
been disturbed by rabbit activity and gull
overhanging by gull. (See back of 7713 sheet for
sketch.)
