COMMENT

Removed after a second layer of the large unburnt stones forming the walls of the house and a second layer of burnt stones had been lifted. Included most of the remaining burnt stones. Taken 1.00 further s. than 4 sq. m. area covered by house, skirting 7227, to include remainder of level area above slope of s. half of cutting removing n.w. end of 7251. Contained noticeably fewer finds than 7253.
