#### ASSOCIATED FEATURES

ASSOCIATED FINDS *Pot, charcoal, daub*

COMMENT *Area covers part of the junction between the dipple (77.12/72.54) and stony (72.11/72.59/60) sections of the cutting, where the stones are more sparse than they are in the S.A. house area and the dipple is loose. It runs between 72.27 and 72.80 on the n.w. and 72.64 and 72.66 on the s.e. Removal of one layer revealed patches of the burning later numbered 77.13 on the w. side and more-stony material on the e., later included as part of 72.89.*
