ASSOCIATED FINDS charcoal, pots, alien stone

COMMENT Investigation showed associated soil a pinkish brown colour changing to yellowish brown just below on the n.e. On the s.w. the burnt chifle continued as an irregular layer towards 7299, another patch of burning. Later investigation indicated that this feature was part of a continuous burnt layer in the vicinity of postholes 7227 and 7280 - see 7713, including sketch on back of sheet.

PHASING

Pre-longhouse - see 7713, cut by postholes 7280, 7227 etc.
