COMMENT Removal of 7268 showed that the underlying material at the n. end of the area included relatively large stones with some soil and chipp, while that at the s. end consisted mainly of small to medium-sized stones with some soil. The removal of 7281 virtually eliminated this difference, so that this area was later treated as part of 7282. The complete absence of finds from this layer, part of which underlay the s. end of the D. A. house, is suggestive.
