COMMENT *First removal revealed distinct difference between area to e. of gull hump extending from section in centre of n. end, where firm chaffle appeared, and area to w. of hump, where soil, stones and loose chaffle continued. Further layers removed to w. of gull - where burning seen to continue s. from 7258 and across centre and e. side s. of gull and firm chaffle. Area of gull increased, but some material remained above bedrock in most parts. Firm chaffle area trowelled a second time and numbered 7288. Noticeably few finds.*

PHASING
