COMMENT Pink chuffe to depth of 5 cm only, then brown chuffe to uneven bedrock. Deepest point in centre of feature, has near vertical bedrock sides, 13 cm high on the w. side but only 6 cm on the e. Just possible stakehole? Immediately W. of hole is shallow groove 25 cm wide.
PHASING ? Possible it forms a circle with 7265, 7718, 7717 and 7718 - see Sketch 5. ? Or a square with 7717, 7718 and 7265.
