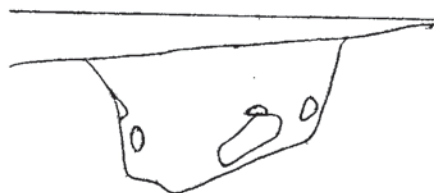
COMMENT Possible stakehole — probable (? posthole)
