COMMENT *Possible stakehole - unlikely, but see below. Removal of superficial layer of dark soil between this feature and 7296 suggested that they were contiguous. Total area measuring 130 cm S/N 130 cm W/E half-sectioned as single entity. Brownish pink chaffle soil (Layer 1) lay above finer-grained, light pink material (Layer 2). Both layers followed change in level of underlying bedrock, which steps down to shelf at n. end (7295) and then to hole at s. end (7296), ? possibly stakehole. See 7296 sheet.*

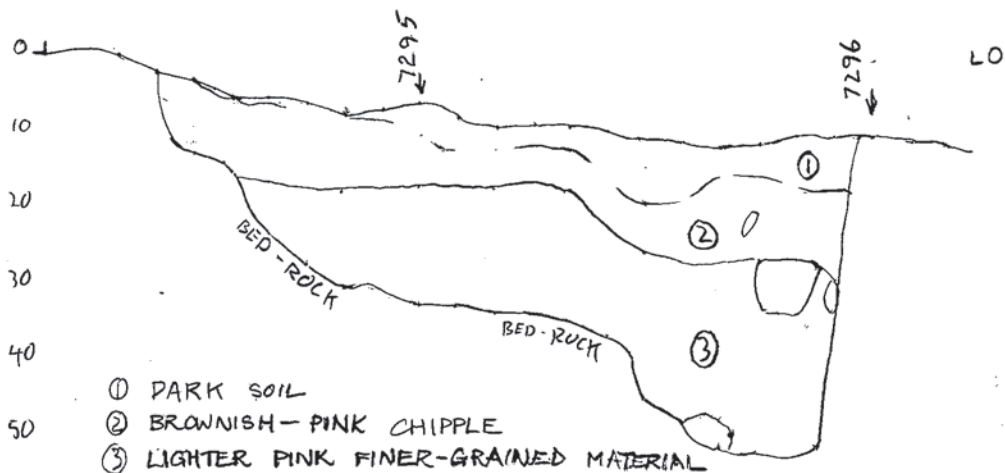
