COMMENT One of a number of patches of burning in
the vicinity of postholes 7227 and 7280.
Investigation indicated that these were all contiguous -
see 7713 - so that there was a layer of burnt
material of very variable thickness over a wide
area. This particular patch had brown soil/
chippie above it and a stony surface below it.
PHASING Pre-longhouse - see 7713, cut by postholes 7280, 7227 etc.
