ASSOCIATED FINDS Bone

COMMENT Stones on surface of pinkish brown soil, which, with some small stones, burnt and unburnt, continued down to a bedrock bottom that seemed too uneven to be anything but natural. Section later extended to connect with that of 7704 since pinkish soil proved to extend over the whole area. Same colour soil later seen to cover wide area to n.w. - PHASING of 7712 - and to extend s.e. into G17.
