COMMENT Distinctive dark brownish orange soil, different from, though perhaps to be related to, orange material of 7707, ~~and~~ below packing stones in 7709 and on e. side of 7227. Removal revealed large stones on s.w. side of 7714 and <sup>in front of them</sup> about 15 cm. of the bedrock shelf that forms its bottom.
