COMMENT *Trowelled back to string-line so section could be drawn. Soils were against sloping bedrock side of 7280. The existence of lighter brown soil to n.n.e. of the grey-brown suggests grey-brown and orange fill post-fire. Grey-brown (Layer 1) is similar to most of fill of 7280; orange is lighter in colour than 7705 but similar to orange material (L2) below packing stones in 7709 and on e. side of 7227. Burnt chippie of 7713 appeared above the grey-brown soil.*

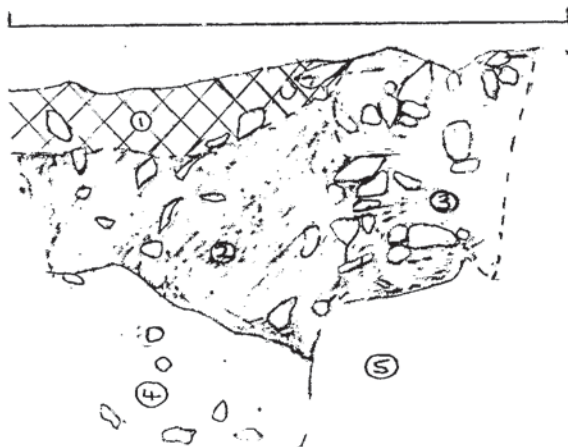
