COMMENT Post- or stake-hole - definite
Sloe first noticed after J. P. had been removing chuffe of 7254. At that time, seen to be in line with possible stakeholes in F16 running parallel to postholes of longhouse. These having come to nothing, 7708 may be isolated, but it is only just off a line between 7265 and 7296 - see sketch 15.
