COMMENT ? Posthole — modified — probable (not fully excavated)  
Bottom seen as bedrock shelf with large angled stones resting on it with some light orange soil between and dark grey-brown soil above. Soil and some stones removed, but other stones, concreted, were not taken out for lack of time, so that the length of 7709 and its relationship to 7714 are not known. Orange soil lighter in colour than 7705, but similar to that of 7707 and that on e. side of 7227, sampled as Layer 4 of that feature.
