COMMENT

Revealed on removal of first layer of 7277 on  
w. edge of cutting and seen to continue  
south-eastwards. Also found below 7289 in  
association with small burnt stones of 7702/04  
and at n. end of 7285. Full extent not  
determined for lack of time, but, from fill of  
posthole 7416, appears to continue into G17. No  
soil samples taken under this number, but such  
soil constituted the fill of 7719 also. Is  
contiguous with 7713 (burnt chaffle) at its n. extremity  
(see over for sketch of boundaries of both).  
Given the top fill of posthole 7416 in G17, it seems  
possible 7712 extends into that cutting; perhaps it = 7395.
