COMMENT ? Posthole - modified - probable (not fully excavated)
 Bottom seen as bedrock shelf below extensive patch of dark orange soil with dark grey-brown soil above (7705 and 7703). Removal of the soil exposed bedrock sides and shelf back to about 15 cm, beyond which large angled stones, partly concreted, appeared. These stones were not taken out for lack of time, so that the length of this feature, and its relationship to 7709 are unknown. The burnt chippie of 7713 appears above the w. edge of this ? posthole and the bedrock beyond the e. edge is stained pink in places.
