ASSOCIATED FINDS *None*COMMENT *Possible posthole - definite (1.9).*

Not completely excavated for lack of time. No hard edge found on W. side, where pinkish brown soil gave way to softish yellow material, presumably disintegrating bedrock relating to drumming and holed n. to side which probably connects with assumed swallow-hole (7716) 50 cm. in. Bedrock edge on E. side and likely concreted-stone bottom. Oval rather than circular shape with gap in centre of S. side, too symmetrical to seem natural but inexplicable without further investigation.

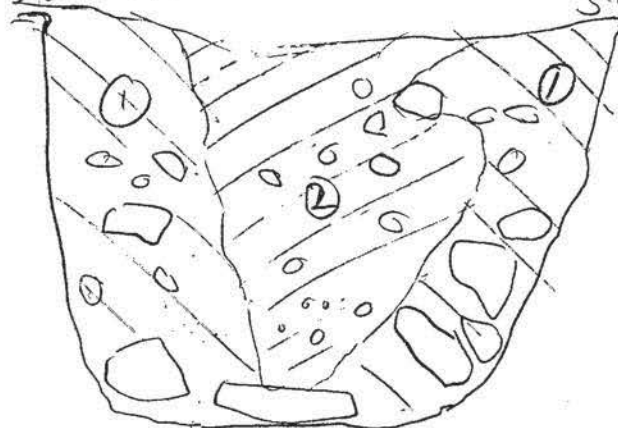
