ASSOCIATED FINDS

COMMENT Investigation as 7277 and 7712 removed at end of season revealed that the stones, many of which were vertical, continued down to a considerable depth and had a great deal of brown soil associated with them, so that the feature was assumed to be the result of root action. It may be significant that the different-coloured, pinkish soil of 7712 came to an end along the line of the vertical stones of 7720 at the s.e. end of this feature at least. cf. 7285.
