Possible PH Approx centre NW 9.30 SW 2.40

Established probable edge. 3rd Augs Commenced half section. Appearance at level ① typical circular area of disturbed stone covering area of soil and small stone

Aug 4 totally removed. Some burnt stone at top. It is now clear that this is in fact a double pit/hole, the two cuts being of approx. equal size, NW-SE to each other. The interrelationship could not really have been apparent in the SW section we took.

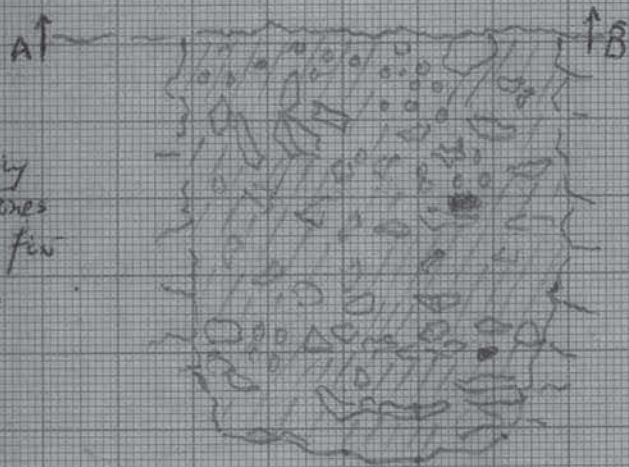
