towards E end of section.

Tree stump in B/G3 NW 9.90 NE 3.70 removed. Potsherds under

27th July. Weather remained dry throughout rest day. Continued kneeling
level ① in B/F3. Removed tree stump in B/F3 (see 24th July)
Surprisingly, tree was sited on area of large flat stones. Some daub
under. Further examination of burned area in B/G3 NW 3.60 SW 6.95
Suggests possible rectangular hearth 45 x 30 cms. Large area F1202

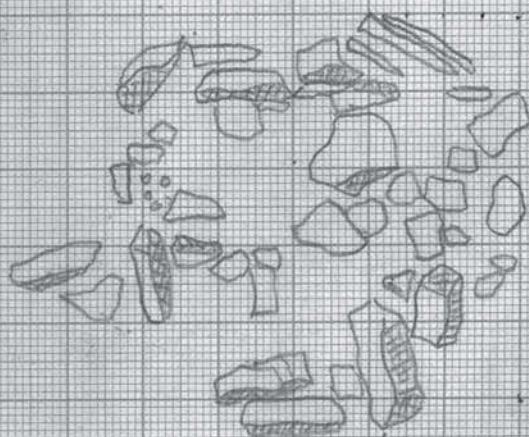
