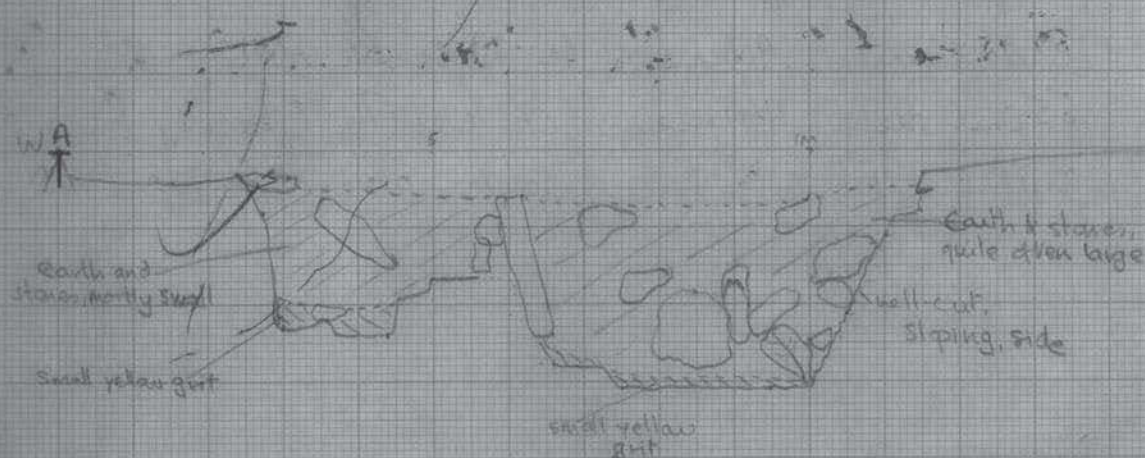
F1208 Probable P.H. in B/G 3 Approx centre NW 8.20 SW 7.10
Commenced half section E-W. Feature first showed as
sub-circular area of small and large stones standing out at
all angles. Beneath this a circular area of soil and smaller
stone with a clearly defined edge of rock.

F1208 A Further clearance reveals small badly formed hole lying
immediately W of larger F1208, and virtually touching

4 Aug Sectioned E-W, both at once. E end 7.5 SW 8.72 NW W end 6.42 SW 7.56 NW
It is considered that F1208 is later than F1208 A.

F1209 Prob PH L B/G 3. Approx Centre NW 10.17 SW 3.95
Half sectioned. Appearance at level ① typical. Small
quantity bone at app 20cms. Max depth 60cms from level ①
Aug 4 fully removed. The top 10cm at N end are fairly regular,
giving a cover so: . Thenceforth regularly cut.
