ASSOCIATED FINDS

COMMENT *Had been numbered 5866 with main hut wall to N, but renumbered as the two are associated, but not contiguous.*

*On excavation of a section through the wall, the floor level 5867 was found to be underneath what had been assumed to be part of the wall. When the CQ Plan 2 was consulted, several slabs that had been assumed to be part of the wall were removed as backfill, and eventually almost all slabs were removed to show floor underneath.*

PHASING

*From this it would appear that many of the slabs originally assumed to be part of this section were actually backfill, but several original wall slabs remained and it is now clear that these were placed on top of the floor 5867.*
