It is immediately adjacent to where the bedrock  
shelves up to the North, so that its northern edge is  
higher than the Southern edge, possibly proving that  
F1660, F1661, F1659 and F1654 would have been deeper  
postholes had not their upper edges been churned up  
up by tree roots and having been removed as  
part of the deeply disturbed bedrock forming layer 2.
