
ASSOCIATED FEATURES

ASSOCIATED FINDS Many bones. Ring-headed pins Large pot frag.

COMMENT Seems to follow wall line only approximately - extends to outside of hut in many places.
A ring-shaped gully filled with burnt stones & with a bone in one place of large flat slabs. Does follow the line of the wall, but is sub-circular rather than straight with angles as the wall was.

PHASING Sectioned in two places, sections drawn.


Section through wall + floor layers F5806 + F5802
