COMMENT

Large ph, with second apparently diagonally through it.  
Filled with small stones, all burnt.

Section not through middle of ph, but across chert on northern side.  
Excavation stopped without defining ph edges - it seems there were too  
subtle to be detected & over-excavation resulted. Diagonal ph appeared  
to be a manufacture of excavation rather than a real feature.

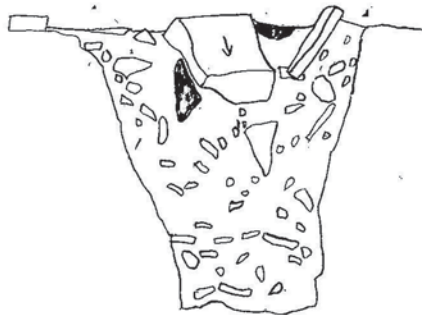
