Excavation revealed this to be a two-period hearth, cutting an earlier I.A. one, FSP52. The first period was a large square stone-lined pit, burnt blue all around. This was then relined on the N & W sides only to produce a much smaller <sup>second</sup> ~~period~~ hearth. This all cut off half of the I.A. hearth FSP52, of which only one side remained.



been the working base.




