depression was sectioned and revealed a well cut, straight-sided post hole c 52cm deep of which the Eastern half had more finds than the West. These included pot, bone, burnt and unburnt, daub, grit etc.

PHASING

This post hole would appear to go with F1964, which is remarkably similar, though has lost over 20cm of its upper part (ie layer 3). Both had lot of finds, diameter at base (31cm)

the same, and diameter at 29cm from base almost the same
(36 ± 38cms)

As distance between them is 3.80m, it seems likely that they may be diagonal corners of a 4 post structure, in which case the other corner holes should also be in J-99. Despite thorough searching in the relevant positions, these were not found.
