COMMENT

Burnt stones on periphery of circle. Post hole cut into gull, horizontal burnt stones on W. side and large broken stone on E side dipping W. - fill whole side down to the base of rotten rock. On E side 4 or 5 parallel layers of flat stones covering central stake-phasing hole another stone roughly vertical.
