DESCRIPTION Posthole  
Post hole suspected after removal of layer ② - circular area of more disturbed rock, with one large burnt stone ~~on~~<sup>on</sup> edge. Quite a lot of large stones in fill, some vertical as packing stones. Edge found with difficulty, as post hole very large and edges rather

ASSOCIATED FEATURES Assumed adjacent corner of four poster to F1821 because so similar (see comment)

ASSOCIATED FINDS Only 1 find in West half. Second half, considerable amount burnt stone and pot fragments, also some charcoal. More packing stones.

DESCRIPTION  
broken near top; sloping out considerably to West. Little burnt stone and only one find in West half.

COMMENT  
This posthole so resembled F1821 (dug last year in K1, and centred at 2.65m. distance) that they were assumed adjacent corners of a 4-poster, and strenuous, but totally unsuccessful attempts were made to find 2 more first to West (F1961 represents one of 3 attempts to find a South West corner), then to East.
