ASSOCIATED FEATURES F1952?

ASSOCIATED FINDS 3 bone fragments and one animal tooth (burnt)

DESCRIPTION Stones in this. Edge found fairly easily; a well cut, symmetrical post hole in undisturbed bedrock.

Contents mostly small stones (less than 7/8 cm) and dark earth. Very few burnt pieces and those very small.

Series of larger slabs (c 20cm) on North West side, sloping down towards centre at c 45°? Packing stones (one of these shown in ~~section~~ section).

COMMENT

The only possible partner for this posthole in excavated area is the posthole base in F1952 - about right depth and diameter.
