In ditch near K1 section Δ SW 4.51, 4.89, 4.64; SE 5.70, 5.30, 5.49
This represented the third attempt to find a post hole in the
ditch-fill to go with Features F1953 and F1821 (K1 1974)
It was noticed as a possibility after the removal of layer ② -
an edge was thought to be visible on the surface of ③, round
~~forming~~ a slight depression.

Probably not a posthole, particularly as the North West
corner post of this conjectured 4-poster did not turn up in
bank (East edge of ditch).
