ASSOCIATED FINDS Tiny fragments of charcoal too small to keep.

of charcoal too small to keep. A number of horizontal slabs, and base not very well defined after removal of 1st half. East side also ill-defined and section may not show full eastern extent of hole.

One packing stone removed with first half. The second ~~PHASE~~ appears to be outside the circumference of the hole, but this is probably because true edge to East not yet found. Removal of second half - East edge still appears to be very nebulous, and the other large vertical stone outside edge of post hole. Base not very flat (1 drawing inc)
